Organizations anywhere in Michigan may apply for MEC AmeriCorps members to support youth enrichment programs, academic tutoring -MEC Reading & Math Corps or site-based program-and/or other COVID-19 recovery efforts.



MEC Summer AmeriCorps Service

MEC AmeriCorps members will serve 37.5-40 hours per week from 6/14/21-8/14/21. Members will be placed at no-cost to the service site with the partner organization. Members earn a living stipend and education award. Site specific training is provided by the host organization.

Partner Organizations

New and current community partners are encouraged to submit applications to indicate their interest and plan for hosting AmeriCorps member(s). Community partners can be Prek-12 schools, non-profits, community-based organizations, or government agencies that facilitate youth programs. Service activities will be determined by what the partner organization determines are youth and community needs. Partners may opt for MEC to provide training for MEC AmeriCorps members to deliver Reading & Math Corps interventions for Prek-8.
