BRIGHTER FUTURES

Up to 95% of students exceeded the target growth rates for same grade peers, and 100% of teachers report that our program has a positive impact on their students and school.

A PROVEN APPROACH

Our interventionists use scripted, evidence-based and high-dosage methods in a proven, highly impactful and individualized manner.

A STRUCTURED ENVIRONMENT

Students receive individualized attention in their own school, three to five days per week, over the course of the school year. We isolate each child's instructional needs and create a tutoring schedule to help them catch up to their peers.

ENGAGED MEMBERS

To get students back on track, we partner with AmeriCorps members—individuals on the front lines of our service. We call them interventionists, but students know them as role models and trustworthy friends.

A SMARTER, STRONGER STATE.

Since 2012, we've provided reading or math tutoring to over 24,000 students across the state of Michigan and in 189 schools.



Pre-K Early Childhood Intervention

One AmeriCorps interventionist serves in each preschool classroom full-time, providing supplemental language, numeracy, and literacy-rich interventions for every child. They may also serve small groups or individual children for brief early numeracy and literacy interventions.



K-3 Reading Intervention Programming

AmeriCorps interventionists serve in elementary schools across the state. Each interventionist serves 15-18 kindergarten through third grade students with 1:1 or pairs with evidence-based literacy intervention for 20 minutes each day.



4-8 Math Intervention Programming

AmeriCorps Interventionists serve in elementary or middle schools. They serve groups of 2-3 students across grades 4 through 8 with supplemental math intervention for 90 minutes a week. This reaches between 15- 30 children a week.
