- Are students who take evening or online classes.
- Doesn't already work in the school building.
- Who are able to make the commitment to serve the entire service term.

WHAT ARE THE MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS TO SERVE?

- Must be 18 years of age or older by your start date.
- Must have at least a high school diploma or recognized equivalent (GED) by your start date.
- Must be either a citizen, national, or lawful permanent resident alien of the United States.
- Must pass mandatory pre-service background checks.
- Must not have served 4 prior terms of service with AmeriCorps State or National.
