



Availability of **Section 35p** funding is subject to State budget appropriation beginning July 1.

## Ready for Section 35p

**Section 35p** of the Michigan State School Aid Act provides funding to support evidence-based, high-impact tutoring during the school day.

Michigan Education Corps aligns directly with the **35p** requirements.

This model allows districts to meet **Section 35p** expectations with minimal additional administrative burden, while strengthening Tier 2 and Tier 3 supports within their MTSS framework.

**Result: Districts gain a turn-key tutoring program aligned to Section 35p without needing to design or manage the intervention program themselves.**

### Additional Funding Sources

Michigan Education Corps programs align with several state and federal funding streams.

#### State Funding

**MI Kids Back on Track (Section 23g)** Supports programming addressing unfinished learning during or outside the school day.

**Section 31a** Supports reading proficiency by Grade 3 and math proficiency by Grade 8.

**Section 35p** Supports implementation of evidence-based high impact tutoring programs.

#### Federal Funding

**Title I, Part A** Supports academic intervention for students most at risk of falling behind.

**Title III** Supports programs serving English Learners.

**Title IV A** Supports well rounded education initiatives, including academic supports.

**Title V B (REAP)** Supports eligible rural school districts.
